



Swan Hills Place Planning

Given the diversity of character, issues and needs across the Swan region, the City prepares 'place plans' for specific areas.

The Swan Hills Place Plan will operate as a *community plan* and will include information about demographics, community visions and prioritised actions and activities for the coming years.

The Place Planning process aims to be participatory, involving community members to work together with local government and other agencies to make decisions for their community. The end product is a plan which provides solutions to address local issues in a sustainable way.

The Swan Hills Place Plan will address the priority issues, opportunities and develop actions for the;

1. Natural environment;
2. Social environment;
3. Economic environment; and
4. Developed environment.

The production of a Swan Hills Place Plan is intended to provide the basis for a review of the *Gidgegannup Rural Strategy* and the development of a structure plan for the Gidgegannup townsite area.

Through the Place Planning process it is hoped that relationships will develop between the local community, community organisations, local government, other government agencies and local businesses.
